PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

General instructions

* All seams are sewn with $1 / 4$ ".
* Press in the direction of the arrows unless instructed otherwise.
* Use a "measure as you go" system, measuring block after each addition to be assured the correct size when finished.
*Border instructions are cut to size. Before cutting measure and use your own personal measurement. (YOPM)


## YARDAGE (Benartex fabric skus in parenthesis)

Fabric 1 - Cherry Red (BECRFERD) 3/4 yard Fabric 2 - Amber (BECRFECO) 7/8 yard Fabric 3 - Fushia (BECRFEWM) 7/8 yard Fabric 4 - Green Curry (BECRFECS) 7/8 yard Fabric 5 - Orchid Purple (BECRFEGP) 7/8 yard Fabric 6 - Cactus Green (BECRFELF) 7/8 yard Fabric 7 - Amethyst Purple (BECRFEIR) 1 yard Fabric 8 - Lime Green (BECRFEBM) 7/8 yard Fabric 9 - French Blue (BECRFEFR) 1-7/8 yards
Fabric 10 - Jade Green (BECRFEJD) 1-1/8 yards Backing: 5-1/2 yards; 3-1/4 yards if using WIDE backing.
Batting: 82" x 97"

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS (Based on 42" WOF-Width of Fabric)

From Fabric 1:

* Cut one 1-3/4" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
* Cut two 1-1/2" x WOF.
* Cut two 2-1/2"x WOF.
* Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF.


## From Fabric 2:

* Cut two 1-3/4" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$.
* Cut two 1-1/2" x WOF.
* Cut two 2-1/2"x WOF.
* Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF.


## From Fabric 3:

* Cut four 2-3/8" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty
$2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " and twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
* Cut four 1-1/2" x WOF.
* Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF.

From Fabric 4:

* Cut six 1-3/4" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
* Cut five 1-1/2" x WOF.
* Cut three 3-1/2" x WOF.


## From Fabric 5:

* Cut eight 2-3/4" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ ".
* Cut two 1-1/2"x WOF.
* Cut two 2-1/2" x WOF.

From Fabric 6:

* Cut nine 1-3/4" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ " and twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
* Cut three $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
* Cut two 2-1/2" x WOF.


## From Fabric 7:

* Cut twelve 2-3/8" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.


## From Fabric 8:

* Cut fourteen $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; sub-cut into twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 12-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.


## From Fabric 9:

* Cut seventeen 2-3/8" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 12-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
* Cut nine 2-1/4" x WOF (for binding).

From Fabric 10:

* Cut twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; sub-cut into twenty $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and twenty
$1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## BLOCK CONSTRUCTIONS (Make 20)

 Follow illustrations for fabric placement.1. Sew a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 1 patch to a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 2 patch. Press to 2.
2. Sew a 1-3/4" x $3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 2 patch to the pair. Press to 2 .

3. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 3 patch to the left side. Press to 3.
4. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 3 patch to the top. Press to 3.

5. Sew a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x $6-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 4 patch to the right side. Press to 4.
6. Sew a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 4 patch to the bottom. Press to 4.

7. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x 8 " Fabric 5 patch to the left side. Press to 5.

8. Sew a 2-3/8" x 6-1/8" Fabric 5 patch to the top. Press to 5.

9. Sew on a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 8{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 6 patch to the bottom. Press to 6.

10. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} x$ 9-1/4" Fabric 7 patch to the top. Press to 7.

11. Sew a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} x$ 11-1/8" Fabric 8 patch to the bottom. Press to 8 .

12. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} x$ 12-3/8" Fabric 9 patch to the top. Press to 9.


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10. Sew a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 6 patch to the right side. Press to 6.

12. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} x$ 11-1/8" Fabric 7 patch to the left side. Press to 7 .

14. Sew a $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} x$ 12-3/8" Fabric 8 patch to the ride side. Press to 8 .

16. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 9 patch to the left side. Press to 9. Block should finish at $15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ 15-1/2".
17. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 14-$ 1/4" Fabric 10 patch to the bottom. Press to 10 .

18. Sew a $2-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 15-$ 1/2" Fabric 10 patch to the right side. Press to 10 .


## QUILT CONSTRUCTION

19. Layout the blocks four across and five down, rotating the blocks as illustrated below. Sew blocks together across, then sew rows together. ${ }^{* *}$ You can play with the placement of the blocks to create your own design.


## BORDER CONSTRUCTION AND FINISHING TECHNIQUES (Follow illustration)

20. Sew the two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 2 strips together. Repeat with the Fabric 4 strips. Trim both to $75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or your own personal measurement (YOPM). Match centers and ends, pin and sew to the left and right sides of the quilt.
21. Sew the two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 1 strips together. Repeat with the Fabric 3 strips. Trim both to $62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or YOPM. Match centers. pin and sew to top and bottom of quilt.
22. Repeat step 20 with the two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 6 and Fabric 2 strips. Trim both pieced strips to $77-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
23. Repeat step 21 with the two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 5 and Fabric 1 strips. Trim both pieced strips to $66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
24. Repeat step 20 with the three $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 4 and Fabric 6 strips. Trim both pieced strips to 81-1/2".
25. Repeat step 21 with the two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 3 and Fabric 5 strips. Trim both pieced strips to $68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
26. Repeat step 20 with the three $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 2 and Fabric 4 strips. Trim both pieced strips to $83-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
27. Repeat step 21 with the two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric 1 and Fabric 3 strips. Trim both pieced strips to $74-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

You may use a 3-1/4 yard piece of wide backing. If using 42 " wide fabric, cut two backing pieces at 2-3/4 yards by WOF. Sew the two pieces along the selvage edges together using a $1^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Trim the selvages off and press to one side. The backing seam will be vertical to the quilt.


Layer top, batting, and backing and quilt as desired.

28. Sew the nine 2-1/4" Fabric 9 strips together. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and sew to top, matching raw edges and mitering corners. Fold to back and hand sew to back. BE SURE TO PUT A LABEL ON THE BACK AND ENJOY!
